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Course Introduction:

Certificate in Child Counselling is an autonomous course especially designed for those who are already working or have flair in working with children. After the completion of this course the learner will be able to understand various techniques of ability enhancement along with the depth of emotional, psychological and behavioural problems and issues which a child might face. Learner will understand the nature of different personalities, developmental milestones and the phases a child goes through. The course will also make the learner aware about the aspects of positive parenting. The application-based nature of the course will empower the learner with the required skill set for working with children effectively. The course also gives an insight about topics such as gender role sensitization, the legal frameworks and also reference points.

Eligibility: Any graduate.

Intake: Maximum 20 students

Mode of conduction: Online

Medium of instruction: Marathi and English

Evaluation: Total 250 marks

- Written paper: Term 1: 50 marks, Term 2: 50 marks
- Presentation: 100 marks
- Internship – 50 marks

Award of Certificate:

Minimum marks required for passing are **40** percent in each exam.

Fee Structure: ₹ 25000/- (Includes 18% GST)

- Employees of MKSSS can avail 10% discount on the total course fees.
- Installment facility is available with 10% extra charge

Students can avail library facility by paying ₹ 1500/- as refundable deposit. The deposit should be collected within two years after the end of the course.
