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Course Introduction:

Certificate in Family and Marriage Counselling is an autonomous course especially designed for those who are willing to work as Family and Marriage Counsellors. After the completion of this course the learner will develop an understanding about the relational concerns and difficulties faced by Indian couples in today's context. The course will develop an insight about the family dynamics of Indian society. The learner will be able to help couples and families to explore difficult thoughts and emotions in a safe manner and develop an understanding about each other's experiences and views. The course encourages the learner to work with an family enhancement approach. The application based course structure will empower the learner with the required skill set for working with couples effectively. The number of participants in any batch will not exceed the number 20. The course will be conducted in online mode.

Eligibility: Any graduate.

Intake: Maximum 20 students

Mode of conduction: Online

Medium of instruction: Marathi and English

Evaluation: Total 250 marks

- Written paper: Term 1: 50 marks, Term 2: 50 marks
- Presentation: 100 marks
- Internship- 50 marks

Award of Certificate:

Minimum marks required for passing are **40** percent in each exam.

Fee Structure: ₹ 25000/- (Includes 18% GST)

- Employees of MKSSS can avail 10% discount on the total course fees.
- Installment facility is available with 10% extra charge

Students can avail library facility by paying ₹ 1500/- as refundable deposit. The deposit should be collected within two years after the end of the course.
